Notice about the protection of your personal data

As part of its public interest tasks, the Luxembourg Reception and Integration Agency (OLAI), the administration acting under the authority of the Ministry of Family, Integration and the Greater Region, collects and uses your personal data with a view to processing your file in fulfilment of its legal obligations established by:

- the amended law of 16 December 2008 on the reception and integration of foreigners to the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg;
- the law of 18 December 2015 on the reception of persons seeking international protection and temporary protection, and amending the amended law of 10 August 1991 on the legal profession.

In its capacity as a data controller, the OLAI processes your personal data in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, applicable as of 25 May 2018.

In the context of particular processing procedures, the OLAI may request your consent, which you may subsequently withdraw.

The purposes pursued by the OLAI in processing your data are as follows:

- Reception, supervision and social protection
- Management of housing structures
- Welcome and Integration Contract and other measures aimed at integration

In the context of the purposes described above, the OLAI may disclose and/or provide access to the processed data, or part thereof, to other competent authorities (namely the Immigration Department of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs, the Health Inspection Department of the Ministry of Health, the services of the Ministry of Education, Children and Youth), to partners (namely the Red Cross, Caritas, ASTI, CLAE, CEFIS) and service providers.

Your data are retained exclusively for the period required to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected or processed, unless otherwise stipulated by any particular legal/regulatory provision.

The collected data may be used for statistical purposes. They may also be retained for public archiving purposes.

In accordance with applicable legislation governing data protection, you have a right of information and access in relation to your personal data. Subject to particular conditions and unless the processing is required in execution of a public interest task, you also have a right of rectification, a right of erasure and restriction of processing, and the right to oppose the processing.

To exercise any of these rights or if you have any questions about the processing of your data, you can contact the OLAI either by post or e-mail. Make sure you attach proof of identity to your request.
