

Civil consultation on the future National action plan on integration and the fight against discrimination 2015-2019

The law of 16 December 2008 on the integration of foreigners in Luxembourg put into place a National action plan on integration and the fight against discrimination (NAP).

The current plan will come to its end in 2014. In order to ensure that the future NAP 2015-2019 may respond to the needs of the target audiences, the *Luxembourg Reception and Integration Agency* (OLAI) would like to consult a multitude of actors in the field of integration. Supporting this consultation, the *Comité de liaison des associations d'étrangers* (CLAE) will organize three workshops on 3 key themes: integration at and through school, the role of the host society and the social, political and economic participation of foreigners. These themes are linked to the common basic principles on integration established by the European Union; principles that are underlying in the law on integration and the current NAP 2010-2014.

The aim of these workshops is to identify the needs of people represented by the associations and organizations. The results of these reflections will be taken into account in the formulation of the future National action plan on integration and the fight against discrimination 2015-2019.

The three workshops will be held at the CLAE, 26 rue Gasperich, Luxembourg on:

- Monday 19 May from 6.30 p.m. to 8.15 p.m. : **Integration at and through school**
- Tuesday 17 June from 6.30 p.m. to 8.15 p.m. : **The role of the host society**
- Tuesday 1 July from 6.30 p.m. to 8.15 p.m. : **Participation**
